A few years later since inception, our learned and much respected Sriman AYYA took over the reins of administration and continues to manage the day to day administration and intellectual responsibilities to make this college a unique institution of the sorts. Considering the nature, quality and dedication of the management under the able stewardship of our Honourable Secretary and Correspondent, UGC very graciously conferred the honours, the coveted status of academic title “Autonomy” in the year 1988. Since that day we are progressing the leaps and bounds towards the realisation of the dreams and visions of the great luminaries of the illustrious Vandayars’ family.

The year 2006 became the red lettered year, as the Honourable President of India Sri A.P.J. Abdul Kalam – the Missile Man of India with a missionary dedication to the fields of science and technologies particularly the space tech, visited our college. It was indeed a memorable year in the long culture tradition and heritage of Sri Pushpam College when the first citizen of India paying global tributes to the cause and principles of establishing such great institution in a memorable Golden Jubilee year 2006.

This institution being rooted in the greatest tradition culture and continuity of the unbroken chain of dedication to the cause of education, marches ahead, overcoming all obstacles if at all any, and reaching the pinnacle of glory on global recognition.

By virtue of my privilege as the Head of the Institution, I indeed feel the honour of presenting the College Annual Report which highlights our various activities and achievements during the academic year 2017-2018

Programmes of Study

The college started in **1956** with only two departments, 11 students and 3 teachers in the bungalow of Vandayars at Poondi, today stands in a sprawling 85 acres of land and **50,000 sq. mts.** of built up area, and functions with **20 departments, 7419 students including 4514 girls and 329 faculty members** of which **120** being Ph.D. holders. The strength of supportive staff of **Non-Teaching cadre is 141.**

20 Undergraduate Programmes, **17 Postgraduate** Programmes, **13 M.Phil.** and **14 Ph.D.** Programmes are offered in our college. Besides these programmes, **5 Postgraduate Diploma**

Programmes are also offered. Totally **66 full fledged** and **approved programmes** and **20 certificate courses** are offered in the Campus.

Staff Elevation:

Dr.V.Nandhakumar has been elevated as **IQAC Co-ordinator**, **Dr.U.Rajan** has been elevated as **Director of SPCTE**, **Dr.R.Shanthi** of English, **Dr.K.Ravichandran** of Physics, **Dr.T.Kumar** of Botany have been elevated as Co-ordinators during this academic year.

Admission of students in the current year:

During this academic year, **2202 UG** students have been admitted of which **1210** are **girls**. The number of **PG** students newly admitted in this academic year is **481** including **349 girl** students. In **M. Phil. 274 scholars** have been admitted in both Full time and Part time, of which **159 are girls**. The current year admission of **Ph.D. scholars** is **75** including **41 girls**.

It is noteworthy to pinpoint here that the College when started at 1956 was only a boys' College and only in the year 2002, the floodgates of admission were opened to girls and today the statistics says that the strength of girls surpasses that of boys.

Award of degrees:

1298 UG Students, **438 PG Students**, **267 M.Phil. Students** and **74 Ph.D. Scholars** have been awarded with Degrees during this academic year.

Grant of Scholarships:

5000 students have been benefitted by the grant of scholarship amount of **Rs.1,91,69,606/-** from the Harijan Welfare and Backward class Departments of the Government of Tamil Nadu. **542** students have been benefitted by the grant of Higher Education Special Scholarship amount of **Rs.43,92,000/-**. **21** students were benefitted by the grant of Minority Scholarship of **Rs.1,26,000/-**.

8 disabled students have been benefitted by the grant of scholarship amount of **Rs.28,000/-**. 4 Ph.D. scholars have been benefitted by the grant of Stipend of amount of **Rs.1,44,000**.

In addition to these Scholarships, the management has distributed an amount of **Rs.7,26,000/-** as scholarship to **99** poor students for 2 semesters in this academic year from its own funds derived from the munificent Endowment of 750 acres of fertile lands in this Delta District.

Infrastructure facilities:

Library:

The college library contains **94,081** volumes of books and 5439 back volumes of periodicals and scholarly periodicals every month. On account of the annual membership to **INFLIBNET** (Information and Library Network) e-resources 54,950 e-books and 4490 e-journals are accessible. Moreover Networking consortium Annual membership and **DELNET** (Developing Library Network) are fully utilized by the members of the staff and the students of the Management Studies. Reprographic facilities are also available in the library.

As per the Gate Register, the average number of users of the Library per day stands as **675** with average number of persons accessed e-books per day is **27**. The reading seats available in the library are **200**.

Hostel:

Separate Hostels for both boys and girls are there in the College Campus. A total number of **280 boys** and **202 girls** do find their hostels as homes away from homes.

Health Centre

With the spontaneous blessings and healthy guidelines of our respected Ayya, the college Health Centre has been rendering excellent service for the past seventeen years. The health centre is provided with a Residential Medical Officer **Dr.S.Veeraiyan** along with one Block Health Supervisor and one Staff Nurse. **Dr. S.Veeraiyan** has been providing round the clock medical service in the campus for the past sixteen years.

This year, we have given treatment for **9259** outpatients comprising students both boys and girls, staff members and rural public from the surrounding villages with drugs worth about **Rs.65,394/-** (Rupees Sixty five thousand three hundred and ninety four only). We have treated **606**

emergency patients including **250** female students who were all seriously ill. In addition to these services, as per our respected Shriman Ayya's guidelines, we have saved **40** families by giving proper treatment, by way of counselling and treatment for drug addition, psychiatric convulsions, egoistic attitudes and interpersonal relationships.

Transport facilities:

The college provides **38 buses and 2 vans** for students and staff members coming from all the four directions and the students are much benefitted by the intrinsic values of regularity, punctuality and discipline that are developed in the minds of the students.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

The IQAC meets regularly every month to discuss the development activities and to oversee the execution of the decisions taken.

The college newsletter under the title **Sri Pushpam News Bulletin** for report the academic activities of the college has been published successfully from year before last years a Quarterly Publications and we are glad that we have stepped into the third year of its publication.

An interdisciplinary Research Journal with ISSN Number entitled **TULASI (Transactions and Ultimatum of Linguistics, Arts and Science Innovations)** is published biannually.
