- 4 Attitude of AVVMSPC Students: 3 employers (100%) reported that the attitude of the students is excellent.
- 5 Course content has enough scope for development of Analytical skill of Students: 2 employers (67%) and 1 employer (33%) agreed that the course content helping in developing analytical skills of the students are as excellent, good respectively.
- 6 Course content has enough scope for development of Logical skill of Students: 1 employer (33%) and 2 employers (67%) answered that the curriculum promoting logical skills of the students are as excellent and good respectively.
- 7. Course content has enough scope for development of Technical skill of Students: 3 employers (100%) responded as excellent, that our curriculum was very useful in developing Technical skills of the students.
- 8 Course content has enough scope for development of creative skill of Students: Regarding the development of creative skills of students using course content, 2 employers (67%), and 1 employer (33%) replied as excellent and good respectively.
- 9. Curriculum designed as per requirements of industry and market: The curriculum portrayed as per requirements of industry and market was accepted as excellent by 2 employers (67%), satisfactory by 1 employer(33%).
