Feedback was collected from the students to evaluate the curriculum, being adopted in A.V.V.M Sri Pushpam College for the year 2018-2019. A total of **116** Students responded to this analysis.

- 1. Syllabus of the course: 96 (83%) Students responded that our syllabus for the course is excellent. 16, (14%) answered as good and 4 (3%) students answered as satisfactory because they are expecting group project as they provide many opportunities to attain a variety of learning skills. Recommendations have been submitted to concerned committee.
- 2. Language papers are given due weightage: 22 (19%), 85 (73%) and 9 Students (8%) answered as excellent, good and satisfactory respectively. Recommendations have been submitted to concerned committee.
